Loganville Football Stadium- Go 985 South 16.3 miles. Take exit 4. Turn left at light on Buford Drive, NE. Go 9.7 miles. Buford Drive becomes Jackson Street, SW. Turn right onto Scenic Highway, SW GA-124 W. Turn left onto GA 20/GA124. Go 9.3 miles. Stay straight to go onto Lawrenceville Highway/GA 81. Turn left onto US 78/Atlanta Highway. Go .4 miles and turn sharp left onto Lee Byrd Road. Take the 1st right onto Old Zion Cemetery Road.

Georgia International Horse Park- Go 985 S. to I-85 S. Take Exit 95A to I285 Bypass. Go 12.1 miles and merge onto I20 East. Take Exit 82 off Interstate 20 in Conyers. Travel North approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. The main entrance to the Park is 2 miles ahead on the right. 1996 Centennial Olympic Parkway, Conyers, GA 30013
