

Web Filter Bypass Request Form

The Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) is a federal law enacted by Congress to address concerns about access to offensive content over the Internet on school and library computers. Gainesville City Schools maintains an Internet content filter that adheres to CIPA regulations. Any student or teacher who wishes to bypass the filter on a specific site and can verify the site contains instructionally relevant material must submit this form to their school principal for his or her approval, who then submits the form to the Director of Technology for further approval and action.
